


NHL HOCKEY IN AUGUST

On August 1, 2020, the National Hockey League returns after the season was paused on March 12 due to the Coronavirus pandemic. There will be a "Play-In" round where 16 teams will compete to earn the final eight playoff positions. This marks the first time the NHL has had playoff games in August.

NHL PLAY-IN TOURNAMENT

IBased on winning percentage when play was suspended on March 12th, the NHL and NHLPA agreed to expand the playoffs to 24 teams by having a play-in round in order to have teams outside the top four of each conference earn a birth in the Stanley Cup playoffs. 16 teams will play a best-of-five series in the play-in round.



FOUR ROUNDS - BEST OF 7

Once the play-in round is complete, the winners will enter the Stanley Cup Playoffs. The top four team in each conference will have played a mini-round to determine top four seeding and all remaining series will be best-of-7 and will be determined by seeding, not by a set bracket. The first round of the playoffs will begin on August 9th. The last possible game of the Stanley Cup Finals is October 2.

NHL BUBBLE CITIES: CANADA EH!

Two cities were selected as bubble sites to host the 2019-2020 NHL Playoffs. Edmonton will play host to the Western Conference teams. Toronto will play host to the Eastern Conference teams. The NHL wanted a Canadian city to serve as a hub city in large part because the numbers for COVID-19 are much lower, but the way the bids from the two cities were structured.



STANLEY CUP FINALS

All of the Conference Finals and Stanley Cup Finals games are set to be played in Edmonton. Conference Finals begin on September 6 with the Stanley Cup Finals commencing on September 20th. If a game 7 is required, the last date that the Stanley Cup will be presented by Gary Bettman is October 2, 2020. This could be the first time a team requires 19 wins to become Stanley Cup Champions.

WHEN WILL THE 2020-21 SEASON START?

The NHL announced tentative dates pertaining to the start of the next NHL season. As per the NHL and NHLPA, Training Camps for the 2020/21 season will open on November 17th. Training camps will last two weeks with the tentative opening of the 2020/21 NHL set for December 1, 2020.
